After nearly 20 years as TEC Manager for the City of Barnesville, Guy Swenson has retired.


In this role, Guy oversaw the city's electric, telephone, internet and Cable TV systems.

Regular City Council Meetings are held the second Monday of every month beginning at 6:30 pm in the City Council Chambers located at the rear of City Hall. The public are welcome. The agenda is posted on the City's website and Facebook page.

Mayor Rick called this regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Member's present were Council members Don Goedtke, Alyssa Bergman, Tonya Stokka, and Brad Field. Absent were Council members Dawn Stuvland and Scott Bauer.

04-14-25-01 Motion Stokka, second Goedtke to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

04-14-25-02 Motion Bergman, second Goedtke to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.

04-14-25-03 Motion Goedtke, second Field to approve the Small Cities Local Government Resolution. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried.

04-14-25-04 Motion Bergman, second Stokka to approve the Small Cities Slum & Blight Resolution. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried.

04-14-25-05 Motion Goedtke, second Bergman to approve the petition for vacation of the platted right-of-way for 7th street SW, in the McGrath's 2nd Addition, in the city of Barnesville, County of Clay, Minnesota, and also to vacate any portion of any Right-of-Way or public easement within the property described and shown as TRACT 1, Auditor's Outlot 25-G to the City of Barnesville, excepting there from the three tracts. Motion to set the public hearing date of May 12, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. Motion carried.

04-14-25-06 Motion Field, second Stokka to allow the Barnesville Food Shelf to use the Event Center for the youth summer lunch program from May-August 2025. Motion carried.

04-14-25-07 Motion Stokka, second Bergman to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2025-03, an ordinance regarding park fees. Motion carried.

## **ELECTRIC RATES**

Barnesville Municipal Power has adopted a seasonal rate schedule which reflects a higher rate only during those months when our cost is higher. The rate is based on the month the power is consumed.

#### SINGLE PHASE RESIDENTIAL

Available to commercial customers with single phase service.

#### THREE PHASE COMMERCIAL

Monthly Base Charge \$28.00 Energy Charge

September-May \$.110 kwh June-August \$.125 kwh

This rate is available to all customers with three phase service who have a calculated demand of 20 KW or less.

# LARGE POWER THREE PHASE COMMERCIAL SERVICE

Monthly Base Charge \$45.00 Demand Charge based on all kw

September-May \$13.40 kw June-August \$17.10 kw

**Energy Charge** 

All kwh \$.053 kwh

This rate is available to all customers for three phase service with a calculated demand over 20 KW. Billing demand will be the maximum demand as measured during any 15 minute interval during the billing period.

#### **ELECTRIC RATE INCENTIVES**

Dual fuel and off peak rates are available to both residential and commercial customers.

#### **DUAL FUEL RATE**

**Dual Fuel Service Rate** 

September-May \$.0480 kwh June-August \$.1290 kwh

This rate is available to all customers with a dual fuel heating system (including heat pumps) that is controlled by the City's load management system.

#### **OFF PEAK RATE**

Off Peak Service Rate:

September-May \$.0480 kwh June-August \$.1290 kwh

This rate is available for electric thermal storage (ETS) space heaters, under concrete slab electric heating systems and electric heated liquid filled under concrete slab heating systems. Off Peak Services must be metered separately and controlled by the City's load management system. Central air conditioners and water heaters do not qualify for the off peak rate.

#### **SECURITY LIGHTS**

Charge per light \$12.25 month

Available to all customers for un-metered lights, 200 watts or less, owned, installed and maintained by the City.

#### **SECURITY FLOOD LIGHTS**

Charge per light \$24.50 month

Available to all commercial customers for un-metered lights, 200 watts or less, owned, installed and maintained by the City

#### **SOLAR PANEL OPPORTUNITY**

Interested in utilizing more "green" energy? Purchase a solar panel in the City of Barnesville Solar Garden on the west side of town. The cost for each solar panel is \$775. You will receive a monthly credit for the energy produced by your panel! You may even qualify for a Federal Tax Credit for renewable energy.

#### WATER HEATER INCENTIVE

Receive a \$2.00 per gallon rebate for the installation of a new electric water heater with a storage capacity of at least 50 gallons, or \$3.00 per gallon for new water heaters with a minimum storage capacity of 80 gallons. Water heaters must be controlled by the city's load management. Demand water heaters without storage do not qualify for this rebate.


